2013 Summer School in Law and Economics at The University of Chicago Law School

## Dear Esteemed Colleague:

Last summer, the University of Chicago Law School offered a new program designed to teach advanced Law and Economics courses to an international academic audience. 75 participants from elite faculties in China and Taiwan participated in the two-week event, which focused on "Property Rights and Private Law."

As the birthplace of Law and Economics, and the home to world known scholars like Ronald Coase, Richard Posner, and Gary Becker, the University of Chicago is dedicated to making the 2013 Summer School a first-rate experience. The Summer School will be held July 8–19 at the University of Chicago Law School, and will consist a two---week program of advanced teaching in Law and Economics, presented by Chicago's most senior experts in the field, and held at the city of Chicago. The theme of the 2013 Summer School is "New Tools in Law and Economics."

We invite academics and scholars from the entire region of East Asia to apply. This will provide opportunities to meet faculty and scholars from countries throughout the region, and to further develop a vibrant collaboration and a lasting community of law-and-economics scholarship.

The fee for participation in the 2013 Summer School (including tuition, room, board, and numerous academic and recreational activities) is \$2500. This rate reflects a significant subsidy. In special cases, the Institute for Law and Economics will award need-based tuition discounts.

I hope you will forward this information to the members of your faculty, and to other scholars who may be interested. We will be sending information about the Summer School to many law schools, but given the reputation and quality of your institution, we hope that your faculty (especially the young scholars interested in Law-and-Economics) will want to apply.
