GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF COURSES

So as to develop everyone's knowledge and skills in the best conditions possible, every language class calls on state-of-the-art teaching techniques and methods. Groups are small (about 20 students) and divided into two subgroups for oral practice and multimedia laboratory hours.

Student can meet regularly with the head of education. They can also use a self-learning programme called Cidlof that was developed by our teachers for students to work on a non-formal interactive basis.

French graduate students - called "moniteurs" in French, meaning instructors - trained to teach French as a foreign language conduct oral skills classes and language lab hours. They provide students with permanent assistance in a friendly atmosphere.

The aim of the survey is to encourage students to meet French people. The survey necessarily bears on France and French people today. Students collect information in their own personal way through conversations and exchanges. The survey findings are presented in written form or orally.

In September, the advanced level course is particularly recommended for those intending to take classes alongside French students during the regular academic year.

NB: Because of the considerable number of contact hours and personal work, students are advised not to have a part time job or to work as an au pair during the course. Class attendance is mandatory.

COURSE FOR TEACHERS: COURSE CONTENT

Language proficiency: oral comprehension and expression; written comprehension and expression; colloquial French; phonetics...

Methodology: current trends in French as a foreign language (DELF, DALF, CEFR or Common European Framework of Reference for Languages); ICT (multimedia laboratories; pedagogical tasks, sequences and resources); use of various types of documents (comic books, fairy tales, documentaries from TV5 Channel); meetings with teachers.

Aspects of modern France: gastronomy, education, the Anjou region, teenagers, contemporary songs, health and social protection in France.

Literature and contemporary geopolitics.

DIPLOMAS

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Intensive course: Each student who has attended the whole course and successfully completed the continuous assessment assignments will be awarded a certificate.

NB: Your grades can be recognized officially by several foreign universities. Students can get credits for the summer programme if previously agreed with their home university.

Course for teachers: a certificate including a detailed description of the course will be awarded to each participant who has attended regularly and has successfully completed the practical assignments of the course (it is possible to obtain credits).

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age: 16
- Documents you need to send to the CIDEF:

Application form duly filled in and signed by the student or his/her parents (legal guardians) if the student is underage.

A 300 € non-refundable deposit that will be deducted from tuition fees (to be sent by international money order or a cheque payable at a French bank and made out to UCO-CIDEF). Please note that bank fees are payable by the student.

An insurance certificate proving that you will be covered during your stay in France (illness, accident, hospital stay).

All fees (tuition, accommodation and food) are due at the beginning of the chosen programme.

If you wish to apply for a second summer programme or for a course during the academic year, another deposit has to be paid.
