Dr. Ying Wu is Professor of Economics and Distinguished Faculty Award recipient at Salisbury University, Maryland. Dr. Wu was selected to serve as U.S. Fulbright Scholar in China in the academic year 2010-2011. He served as Visiting Senior Research Fellow at National University of Singapore. He was twice honorably recognized in *Who's Who among American Teachers* among 2% American teaching faculty.

Dr. Wu's scholarly research explores issues of international economics, monetary policy, exchange rates, and macroeconomic management. His paper on macroeconomics of processing trade is the Winner of Best Paper Competition in Economics at the 35th annual meeting of Academy of Economics and Finance. Many of his publications appear in quality international journals such as *Journal of Macroeconomics*, *Atlantic Economic Journal*, *International Review of Economics and Finance*, *Journal of Economics and Finance*, *Contemporary Economic Policy*, *Pacific Economic Review*, and *Journal of International Financial Markets, Institutions and Money*.
